Enjoy a day of open-ended, free-choice, child-directed play and learning. Our students will explore, discover, immerse, imagine and connect with the natural and cultural wonders of the Bay Area as they play in our unique exhibitions.

We will meet at the Discovery Museum at 9:15. Snack will be provided mid-morning. This excursion is self-guided. The Wave workshop is a place to discover the science of waves and wind, a place to race boats and dress up like sea creatures. We will visit Bay Hall, an interactive simulation of the ports of SF and Oakland, with boats and trains. Next is the much loved art studios. Kids can color, build with moon sand, make collages and paint on walls! Please feel free to stay and have lunch in the picnic area by Lookout Cove, an outdoor play area.

If you are providing the science or art lesson for the day, please provide an appropriate on-site lesson. A simple lesson is a 'question of the day' to ask the children. Wednesday's snack person will provide snack for the children. Look for the carpool sign-up sheet on the bulletin board at school.

Directions from Hansel & Gretel: From Argyle Road, turn right on Ap-pian. Take I-80W toward Oakland. Take the Fitzgerald Drive exit toward 580/San Rafael. Turn right onto Richmond Pkwy for 5.1 miles. Slight right onto Castro St for 1.7 miles. Merge onto 580W for 5.9 miles. Take the Sir Francis Drake Blvd exit for 0.4 miles. Merge onto E Sir Francis Drake Blvd for 1.4 miles. Merge onto US-101S toward San Francisco via ramp on left.

Proceed 8.4 miles south on 101. After the tunnel and just before the Golden Gate Bridge, take the second and last Sausalito exit and follow signs to East Fort Baker and the Bay Area Discovery Museum.
