Transportation:

We will be taking BART! We'll take BART from the Orinda station to Oakland's 12th St station. We need to be on the train **leaving Orinda at 8:44** to **arrive at 12th St at 8:57**. It will take us a few minutes to walk from the BART to MOCHA and need to arrive at 9:15 for our art day and tour.

If you are providing the science or art lesson for the day, please provide an appropriate on-site lesson. A simple lesson is a 'question of the day' to ask the children. Friday's snack person will provide snack for the children. Look for the carpool sign-up sheet on the bulletin board at school.

Directions from Hansel & Gretel if you choose to drive: From Argyle Road, turn right on Appian. Take I-80W toward Oakland for 12.3 miles. Take I-880 S toward San Jose for 2.7 miles. Take the Broadway exit. At the light, turn right on 5th street. Stay straight on 5th street for 0.5 miles. Turn left onto Martin Luther King Jr Way. Proceed 0.2 miles. Turn right onto 9th St. MOCHA is on the left.
